ESSER III Plan

The Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER III) was established in March of 2021 in order to help school districts impacted by the global pandemic. Flat Rock-Hawcreek School Corporation's preliminary allocation is \$737,448, of which 20% must be used to address learning loss.

The Flat Rock-Hawcreek School Corporation plans to use these emergency funds as follows:

Learning Loss/Accelerated Learning

- Director of Accelerated Learning will conduct a district wide needs assessment and target funding and/or resources to programs for students impacted by coronavirus.
- Behavior Coaches at each building to provide personal emotional support to students
- Interventionalists will assist in the classroom to help maintain small working group sizes as well as offer support for the classroom teacher.

Social and Emotional Health

- Additional school-based counselors to offer full wrap-around services to students and families
- Creating partnerships with mental health providers to allow for more competitive wages and benefits for employees

Operational Expenses

- PPE and supplies to aid in safely operating in-person school
- Filter upgrades
- Addition of safe spaces (regulating rooms) for student and staff social/emotional well-being

As a condition of receiving these funds, each school district had to create, present, and offer public comment on the school's plan for reopening. Flat Rock-Hawcreek administration presented this plan at the school board meeting on August 3, 2021, where the public had the opportunity to comment regarding the plan.
